Wednesday Night Devotion

Start with Roses, Thorns and Buds: somewhat of an icebreaker to get the group talking, everyone has to say one rose which is something good that happened or a way you saw God today, then a thorn you don't have to have one but it's something that didn't go well that day and a bud is something that you saw that has the potential to become a rose.

1. Half way through the week, how is everyone's work site?
2. How did the worship service and the message speak to you?
 - a. Try and get a few students or chaperones to share what they got out of the service
3. How can you apply this on work site tomorrow?
4. What is one way that you can implement what the speaker said by the end of the week into your own lives?
 - a. Try and get the students to make a connection to something back home that they might be able to apply this too
5. So we took up the first round of offering for the the well project in Cuba, what are your thoughts on this project?
 - a. Is God calling you to help with project?
 - b. Did you feel God speak to you about international needs or mission work?
