### **PROJECTS in VERMONT:**

#### **VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL/BACKYARD BIBLE CLUB**

- VT18-005**      Vacation Bible School      S. Wheelock, Vermont  
A team of volunteers is needed to coordinate with two local churches to put on a VBS. The objectives are to creatively teach children the Word of God, to reach out to children and families in the local community, and to help equip believers for ministry/service. Tennis court project entails turning existing court into a combination tennis and volleyball court. This requires painting existing fence and applying finish to the court itself.
