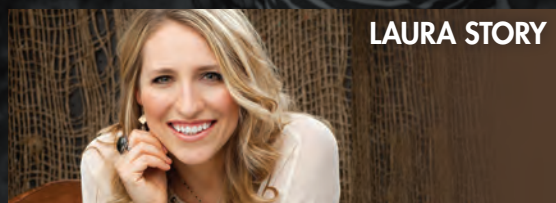

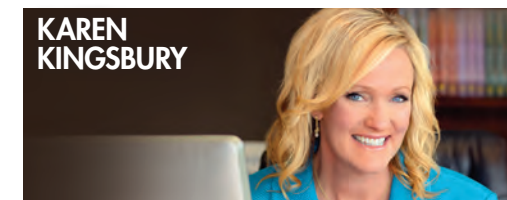
BOB GOFF

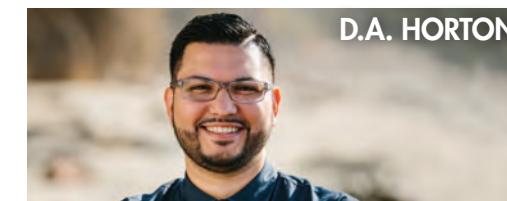
KAREN KINGSBURY
