Need to Know

Cost is \$21 per person, per night, and includes lodging, three meals and supplemental volunteer insurance.

Our workdays are Monday – Saturday (no Saturday evening meal). The camp is closed on Sunday.

RV sites are available only by reservation.

Teams need to bring their own tools (some tools can be provided), towels, washcloths, toiletries and bedding (don't forget your pillow).

Volunteers must be at least 13 years old.
