### VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL/BACKYARD BIBLE CLUB

**Building Renovation for Church**

Baltimore, Maryland

Church currently serves thousands of meals annually to hungry people, coats to children, sports camps in the summer, jobs for youth, after school ministry, and celebrate recovery - all in the context of sharing the gospel of love of Jesus Christ in their community.
