

## Statement on COVID-19

Issued March 17, 2020

In light of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, we at Deep Impact and Baptists on Mission understand that you have concerns and questions about many things, including our summer plans for Deep Impact camps, whether inside or outside of North Carolina. We want you to know that we are closely monitoring the situation, as it changes not only from day to day, but from moment to moment.

The health and safety of our participants, summer staff, and ministry partners is of utmost importance, and we will make decisions regarding our summer camps with that at the forefront of our minds. With that said, because our camps do not begin until June and as a result of the ever-changing nature of the situation, we are not in a place currently to make any decisions about Deep Impact 2020.

Please understand that we will continue to pay close attention to the recommendations of government officials and agencies, the trends as presented by healthcare data, and the overall nature of the pandemic. We discourage any group from cancelling at this time, especially at this early date. Be further advised that, if a need should arise such that we choose to cancel your Deep Impact week this summer, we will issue a full refund of your camp deposits and fees.
