

2020 World Missions Week Background Check Information and Form

(PLEASE BRING TO WORLD MISSIONS WEEK– DO NOT MAIL)

A background check must be performed on each person attending World Missions Week 18 years old and above. This includes both and adults who are 18 years old and above. You, as a church, can choose which agency is used to perform the background checks on each person 18 years old and above. If your church already provides background checks, you can use this information. North Carolina Baptist Men/Baptists on Mission has a contract with Protect My Ministry in which you can obtain background checks. The link for Protect My Ministry is: <http://protectmyministry.com/ncbaptist/>. The Baptist State Convention of North Carolina uses First Point. If you would like to set up an account with First Point, please contact Scott Hall at 800.288.7408, ext. 3037 or send him an email at shall@firstpointresources.com. You will be given a special rate of \$10 per person for the appropriate background check. He will be glad to help you set up an account. If you choose to use First Point, setting up an account takes some time. If any background check comes back with a felony or serious driving issue, you must contact Rick Trexler to discuss issue at 919.917.4419 (No personal information needs to be shared, only incident or issues)

As a reminder, you do not have to use Protect My Ministry or First Point.
