**NOTE for ALL NATIONAL TEAMS for 2026:** The United States is hosting the 2026 World Cup June 11 – July 19. It is expected that airline travel will fill up much sooner than normal – and that prices will be higher than normal. Matches will be held all over the United States. It is recommended that you book your travel early – much earlier than you might do in a normal year. Likewise, vehicle rental may also be affected in some areas.

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### **PROJECTS in IDAHO:**

**RM26-033**      **Addition to Church Building**      Grangeville, Idaho  
Small construction teams (6-12) are needed to assist a Baptist church in the construction of a 4000 square foot addition that will alleviate their current problem of their elderly members having to traverse steep basement stairs to attend church functions.
