CONSTRUCTION / MAINTENANCE

HW25-004 Construction and Outreach (Kihei BC - Michael Komatsu) Kihei, Maui
Teams are needed to help church do some much-needed repairs to a building adjacent to their sanctuary. Most urgent is: 1) electrical – some lights do not work and some re-wiring may be required; 2) foundation work – pier and post foundations need to be leveled (shimmed?). Some may need to be replaced. Other work may include some window replacement, light fixtures repaired or replaced, and interior walls installed to create classrooms. Team would need those with electrical and construction expertise and skill. Team would be asked to help with materials cost. Requestor can work with team leader about which tasks team might be able to perform and any associated costs. Team can stay in the church building if they wish. A small kitchen if available to teams' use. Team will need to rent vehicle for the week as church does not have a vehicle.
Length of assignment: One Week
Preferred dates: Anytime 2025
Cost: Transportation to Maui, vehicle rental, team food, materials cost

HW25-005 Church Construction Projects (Kahului BC – Jay Haynes) Kahului, Maui
A team is needed to remove carpet and replace with new in church auditorium. Would like to pull the old carpet up and polish the concrete underneath. There may be some minor carpentry needs around the walls and the stage area. Church would also like to do some water irrigation around the parsonage. Requestor can explain all. Host church would provide the needed materials. If team could bring some tools, that would be great. Otherwise, they may need to be rented once onsite. There could also be some painting, landscaping, and small carpentry needs at church or at neighboring church – so, plenty to keep a team busy! Team can stay in the church, which has A/C air mattresses, and cots. DR shower trailer would be available for team's use, as well as the church kitchen.
Length of assignment: One Week
Preferred dates: Anytime 2025
Cost: Transportation to Maui, vehicle rental, team food

ONE-WEEK CAMP MAINTENANCE TEAMS

HW25-003 Construction/Maintenance/Renovation Waianae, Oahu
Teams of 8-15 volunteers needed for various maintenance and possible construction projects at Pu'u Kahea Conference Center. Projects could include repairing and/or replacing plumbing, flooring, roofing, tile work in the bathroom, etc. May include some cleaning, painting and landscaping as well. Need teams that are skilled in these areas and ready to work hard. It is preferred that teams have a 2:1 male-female ratio. Donations appreciative to assist with building material costs, but not required. Team will need to provide their own transportation to and in Hawaii. Housing is available at the campus price to be determined. Teams will need to purchase their own food and will be able to use a kitchen on campus for meal prep.
Length of Assignment: 7-10 days
Preferred Dates: September to November 2024; and then January-May and September-November 2025
Cost: Travel to Hawaii, food, lodging

CAMP ASSISTANTS (ONE MONTH MINIMUM)

HW25-002 Volunteer Camp Staff Waianae, Oahu
Couples are needed year-round to be volunteer staff at Pu'u Kahea Conference Center, helping to maintain the facility. Work may include housekeeping, general maintenance and cleaning, landscaping, laundry, and other duties as needed. Volunteers work 5 days and are off 2 days per week. Individuals may also be considered, depending on housing availability. Need those who are self-starters, in good physical condition and able to put in full day's work. Volunteers will need to provide their own transportation to Hawaii. PKCC can provide a vehicle for local transportation for days off but volunteers are responsible for gas. A studio efficiency apartment is provided

for the couple's lodging. Volunteers will need to provide their own meals as the camp does not currently offer food services.

Length of Assignment: One month minimum commitment, and up to three months possible

Preferred Dates: January – November 2025 (specific dates worked out with camp leadership)

Cost: Travel to Hawaii and food
