VBS/CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

- HW25-001 Spring Break Vacation Bible School/Minor Church Repairs Haleiwa, Oahu
A team experienced with working with children is needed to conduct a Vacation Bible School for elementary children during Spring Break. Will need those to lead in all aspects of VBS – Bible story, crafts, music, recreation, and snack. Team will need to provide VBS materials. Team will also be asked to do some minor repairs in and around the church building if possible. This may include some painting, replacing some interior doors, replacing light fixtures, etc. Host church will provide materials and tools. Team may want to bring some tools if they wish. Team will stay in a VRBO/dorm-type facility which has showers and kitchen. The team will need to pay \$500 for a cleaning fee related to use of the facility. Any donation toward the cost of utilities for the week is appreciated as well, but not mandatory. Church also has a kitchen the team can use. Team will need to rent a vehicle. **Note:** Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information from BOM concerning options.
Length of assignment: 7-8 Days
Preferred Dates: March 14-21, 2026 (not flexible)
Costs: Travel to HW, team food, VBS materials, \$500 cleaning fee for lodging, vehicle rental
- HW25-002 Christmas Break Vacation Bible School Haleiwa, Oahu
A team of 8-10 experienced with working with children is needed to conduct a three hour Vacation Bible School for elementary children during their Christmas Break. Will need those to lead in all aspects of VBS – Bible story, crafts, music, recreation, and snack. Team will need to provide VBS materials. Team will stay in a VRBO/dorm-type facility which has showers and kitchen. The team will need to pay \$500 for a cleaning fee related to use of the facility. Any donation toward the cost of utilities for the week is appreciated as well, but not mandatory. Church also has a kitchen the team can use. Team will need to rent a vehicle. **Note:** Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information from BOM concerning options.
Length of assignment: 7-8 Days
Date of Event: December 28, 2026 – January 1, 2027 (not flexible)
Costs: Travel to HW, team food, VBS materials, \$400 cleaning fee for lodging, vehicle rental

BAPTIST CAMP MAINTENANCE TEAMS

- HW26-004 Construction/Maintenance/Renovation Waianae, Oahu
Teams of 8-15 volunteers needed for various maintenance and possible construction projects at Pu'u Kahea Conference Center. Projects could include repairing and/or replacing plumbing, flooring, roofing, tile work in the bathroom, etc. May include some cleaning, painting and landscaping as well. Need teams that are skilled in these areas and ready to work hard. It is preferred that teams have a 2:1 male-female ratio. Donations appreciative to assist with building material costs, but not required. Team will need to provide their own transportation to and in Hawaii. Housing is available at the campus price to be determined. Teams will need to purchase their own food and will be able to use a kitchen on campus for meal prep.
Length of Assignment: 7-10 days
Preferred Dates: September to November 2025; and then January-May and September-November 2026
Cost: Travel to Hawaii, food, lodging

BAPTIST CAMP ASSISTANTS

- HW26-003 Volunteer Camp Staff Waianae, Oahu
Couples are needed year-round to be volunteer staff at Pu'u Kahea Conference Center, helping to maintain the facility. Work may include housekeeping, general maintenance and cleaning, landscaping, laundry, and other duties as needed. Volunteers work 5 days and are off 2 days per week. Individuals may also be considered, depending on housing availability. Need those who are self-starters, in good physical condition and able to put in full day's work. Volunteers will need to provide their own transportation to Hawaii. PKCC can provide a vehicle for local transportation for days off but volunteers are responsible for gas. A studio efficiency apartment is provided for the couple's lodging. Volunteers will need to provide their own meals as the camp does not currently offer food services.
Length of Assignment: One month minimum commitment, and up to three months possible
Preferred Dates: January – November 2026 (specific dates worked out with camp leadership)
Cost: Travel to Hawaii and food
