EVANGELISM/OUTREACH/COMBINATION

NH25-003 Creative Adult Outreach at Community Festival

Concord, New Hampshire

A creative adult-led team is needed to assist local church for outreach to adults during a three day community festival in the state capitol – Thursday, June 26 through Saturday, June 28. Host church will rent a 30 foot booth and work with team leader in determining the most creative and effective way to use the space over the three days.
