There is a \$350/person cost for the week that covers training, breakfast Tuesday-Friday, supper Tuesday-Thursday, guided ministry activities and ministry materials. Multiply Maine will provide housing at their facility and other local facilities. Beds (primarily) or air mattresses, linens, sheets, pillows and towels are provided (for up to 30 volunteers). Team will be responsible for travel meals and lunches in the field.

Length of assignment: Monday-Friday

Preferred dates: Fall 2026 (flexible, requestor will work with team leader to secure a date)

Cost: Travel to Maine, some meals, group housing and \$350/person
