CHILDREN'S MINISTRY/VBS/ BYBC

PA25-001 Children's Ministry and Outreach Events

Harrisburg, Pennsylvania

Teams are needed throughout the summer to help church reach children and their families for Christ – possibly at two locations – the church, and a nearby food ministry location. This may involve conducting kid's clubs (BYBC), sports camps, craft camps, etc. depending on the team's interests and skills. Church does a food give-away 1st and 3rd Saturday most months, which team can potentially participate in. There may also be some small construction/maintenance needs if team is interested. Team is asked to provide all needed ministry supplies. Volunteers will need to be experienced in working with children, and be willing to engage people in conversation. Team leader can reserve lodging at nearby volunteer house which has showers and a kitchen for teams to use. There is also a small kitchen available at the church. <u>Note</u>: Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information from BOM concerning options for this.

PA25-003 Vacation Bible School or Sports Camp

Lancaster, Pennsylvania

A team of 10-15 is needed to assist church in reaching families in their community by conducting a Vacation Bible School (or a sports camp if team is interested). Need those for all aspects of children's ministry, including Bible lesson, recreation, crafts, music, snacks, etc. If sports camp, team will need to be experience in leading one. Team will go door to door in the morning, praying for people, distributing tracts, and inviting children to VBS/Sports Camp. VBS/Sports Camp will be held afternoon. Need team that is energetic and love to work with children. Team leader can talk with requestor about materials needed and pre-event promotion. Team can stay in church SS rooms, church member homes, or local hotel. Church kitchen is available for teams' use. Team will need to provide their own transportation <u>Note</u>: Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information from BOM concerning options for this.

Need those for all aspects of children's ministry, including Bible lesson, recreation, crafts, music, snacks, etc. Need team that is energetic and love to work with children. Team leader can talk with requestor about materials needed and specific team assignments. Could use materials that team used at their church, or pastor could order materials for team to use. Team can arrange to stay at mission house in nearby Harrisburg, which has kitchen. There is also a church in Harrisburg that sometimes houses mission teams. Host church also has a small kitchen that team can use. <u>Note</u>: Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Chesterfield, New Jersey

A team of 12-20 is needed to assist church in conducting a Kids Adventure Camp (like VBS) that will take place at a nearby military base as part of the church's mission strategy to reach out to military families. Need those for all aspects of VBS/BYBC ministry, including Bible lesson, recreation, crafts, music, snacks, etc. Need team that is energetic and love to work with children. Requestor will work with team leader about what activities will be planned, and curriculum to be used. Team can stay in the church, which has bathrooms and a kitchen that team can use. Showers would be in church member's homes. Local hotels and Air BnB could also be options. **Note**: Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information concerning options for this.

Day includes pony rides and the local police give ATV .The "kid's zone" includes sing-a-longs and puppet shows. This is a big outreach for this church. They need a good, active, people-loving team to help them reach their community for Christ! Hotels, Airbnb, and camping options are available in the area. A kitchen is available in the church for meal preparation. <u>Note</u>: Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information from BOM concerning options for this.

PA25-009 **Renovation Projects at State Office**

Harrisburg, Pennsylvania Teams are needed to help with some remodel projects at the state office of the Baptist Resource Network in Harrisburg. The BRN supports the work of churches and church plants all over Pennsylvania and South New Jersey, and have been great partners with North Carolina. By utilizing volunteer teams, they are able to stretch their precious mission dollars into other areas of advancing the Kingdom. Projects may include: 1) removing rolled carpet in the hallway – aprox. 70' x 5' – and installing carpet tiles; 2) sand and paint 25' tall exterior BRN sign, 3) paint facia and exterior trim of the building 4) re-roofing the building – approx. 40 squares on 1.5 story building... Requestor will work with team leader in determining what tasks team may accomplish. The BRN will provide all materials (but if team or mission church wants to contribute some it would be greatly appreciated). Housing options include the BRN Mission House (just across the street) at no cost. Team is responsible for their own meals. Meals may be prepared in Mission House kitchen.

Needs include caulking windows and trim, painting trim, and re-pointing brick exterior. Housing options include the BRN Mission House (just across the street) at no cost. Team is responsible for their own meals. Meals may be prepared in Mission House kitchen.

PA25-011 Sump Pump Room Repairs

A team is needed to re-do the walls and shelving of a small sump pump room owned by the Baptist Resource Network of Pennsylvania/South Jersey. By utilizing volunteer teams, they are able to stretch their precious mission dollars into other areas of advancing the Kingdom. Tasks will include tearing out damaged drywall, treat for any possible mold/mildew, install new plastic wall board, remake shelving system to house sump pump battery backup system, and paint the room. The BRN will provide all materials (but if team or mission church wants to contribute some it would be greatly appreciated). Housing options include the BRN Mission House at no cost. Team is responsible for their own meals. Meals may be prepared in Mission House kitchen.

PA25-013 Church Building Remodel

Pastor needs small teams (4-6) to help in refurbishing of house that is used as a retreat center for churches and pastors suffering burnout. This is in a remote, wooded area of Pennsylvania. Tasks would include: 1) installing metal soffit, fascia, and siding, 2) porch post and beam replacement, 3) installing a ¾ bath with shower and toilet, 4) painting of interior cement block walls, and more. Team may also help with the cutting and splitting of firewood for year-round use. Teams will be asked to help with construction materials. Requestor will discuss with team leader. Teams can stay in a cabin located on-site. Showers and bathrooms available, as well as kitchen for preparing meals. Team will need to bring sleeping bags.

Various Areas, Pennsylvania A team is needed to prayerwalk strategic areas in Pennsylvania as well as visit pastors and wives to give encouragement. The work of these pastors and church planters is challenging. Progress is slow, and often discouraging. Many of these families have young children, some with special needs. Intentional prayer and care are very important to these pastor's families. These visits may involve taking the family out to eat, listening for needs where volunteers can help their ministry, praying with them, and giving gifts. The requestor will assist team in knowing specific areas to visit and develop a schedule. After leaving the town, the team should continue to pray specifically for the pastor's family, send cards of encouragement, emails or texts. The sending of additional mission teams can be planned with the requestor and coordinated through BOM Partnership mission. This long-term encouragement could make the difference in the pastor's family remaining steadfast in sharing Christ in their church and community. Materials cost could include: Gift cards, small bags of gifts of encouragement for members of the family. Prayer walking training materials for team if needed are highly recommended prior to trip. Need volunteers for this who are passionate for encouragement and prayer, and good listeners. Team will need to provide their own transportation. Housing may be found at local churches, motels, homes and/or local retreat center. Kitchens are available for team's use. Restaurants are also available. Requestor will work with team in putting together a successful ministry plan. Note: Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18. Team leader will be sent information from BOM concerning options for this.
