PROJECTS in WYOMING:

CAMP COOKS

RM21-002 Camp Cook Team Casper, Wyoming
One team of 8-12 volunteers is needed to cook for campers who are attending camp (Children's Camp July 5-9). Meals will be planned and food purchased by the camp director. Team will be responsible for all prep, cooking, serving and clean up after each meal. The day begins early and is finished by around 7:00 p.m. Most days will have a couple hours to rest and relax in between. Volunteers with cooking skills and able to lift heavy pots and pans are needed. Team will need to provide their own transportation. Housing will be provided for the team while at camp. Food will be provided while camp is in session and team is cooking for campers. **Note:** Team will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all team members over the age of 18. Team leaders will be sent information from NC Baptist Men concerning options for this.

CAMP MAINTENANCE

RM21-011 Chainsaw/Fence Mending/Maintenance Casper, Wyoming

Some light construction projects are also needed in preparation for reopening camp. Teams will need to be prepared for some heavy lifting, chainsaw work and light construction. Housing will be provided in our newly renovated "cooks house" or in our large dream cabin. Teams will be responsible for purchasing food and preparing their own meals. A commercial kitchen is available for use by teams for this. Camp has an old minivan that is available for cooks to use in going into town to purchase food. Most teams also prefer to rent a car so they can go sightseeing or go into town to shop.

Volunteers need to be skilled in carpentry, plumbing and electrical. Lodging will be provided. Food will be provided but it will be helpful if some of the volunteers will help with food preparation.
